❖ **Check – In:**

- **Entrance into the Pavilion will not be allowed until 6:00pm** on November 12, 2016.
- **Stalls will remain locked** until horses are checked in at the show office with proof of a negative 2016 Coggins.
- Entrance must be made through the **EAST doors** of the pavilion (doors facing Farm Lane Rd)

❖ **Stalls:**

- **Payment is required for a stall reservation to be made.**
- Stalls are assigned according **first come first serve**. Once stalls are filled in the main barn, we will be assigning then in the South Barn, unless otherwise notified. If you add horses to your list *after* the main barn has been filled **they will be put in the South Barn.**

❖ **Classes:**

- Classes are finalized **5 classes before** that class starts, so entries and changes must be made prior to that **in the show office.** (i.e. You want to enter Class 16, you must enter by Class 11)
 - MSUHA reserves the right to split, combine, or cancel classes. **NO REFUNDS** will be given for entry fees. Rider's age is their age as of January 1, 2016.
 - Exhibitors must check-in at entry gate two classes prior to their entered classes.
 - Any class size over twenty competitors is likely to be split and call backs will occur
- ❖ MSUHA is NOT responsible for any damage, loss or injury to any property, horse or person connected to the MSU Green and White Show.

Horse entry for the Green and White Fuzzy show will only be allowed thru the East doors (doors facing Farm Lane Rd).

Also no entry will be allowed before 6:00pm.
